When Chanie was there, he, like all children, wanted to go home, so he made the decision to run away. He did not make it home, succumbing to the elements early on in his journey.

The students partnered up with an older cohort in the school and walked through the Stony Mountain community, bringing awareness to the need for reconciliation and to remember and honour those who have gone through the residential and day school system.
