Non-urgent or Emergent Care

Should newly arrived people from Ukraine require non-urgent or emergent care, they can access the Walk-In Connected Care (WICC) Clinics.

Settlement workers are asked to call ahead first and advise that they are coming and who the WICC can expect.

Hours of operation vary, please call ahead or check the website for details.

Walk-In Connected Care is provided by nurse practitioners, physician assistants and registered nurses.

Non-Crisis Child and Adolescent Mental Health Centralized Intake

Centralized Intake provides a central point of entry for all services in the Shared Health Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service.

This service enables clients and families to access the appropriate programs and services based on the individual needs of the client and their family.

Street Connections

A mobile van service run by WRHA Public Health that provides a variety of services and resources:

Public Health Nurses are in the van Fri. & Sat. evening. They offer testing for various STIs, as well as pregnancy testing, prenatal services, information about pregnancy options, vaccines against hepatitis A & B, the flu, and other illnesses, care for minor wounds and abscesses, and referrals to other programs and services

Street Connections provides clean injection supplies. We also take used needles and safely dispose them. We also provide condoms, lube, and safer sex information.

Street Connections does home visits for needle exchanges and some nursing services.
